



Operator Safety Acknowledgement Form



Please initial next to each item:

I understand that I am responsible for the equipment until the rental company arrives to pick it up even if they are late due to other pickups and deliveries.

I understand that while participants are in the inflatable equipment, **A RESPONSIBLE ADULT MUST BE SUPERVISING AT ALL TIMES – no exceptions!** No rough play!

I will ensure that all riders REMOVE their **SHOES** and any **SHARP OBJECTS** before entering the inflatable. Sharp objects include **EYEGLASSES, TOYS, JEWELRY** and any item that could scratch, cut, or scrape the unit or another rider.

I understand that **NO FOOD, DRINKS, ANIMALS, SAND, GUM, PAINT, PENS, MARKERS (permanent or otherwise), CRAYONS, FIREWORKS, GLITTER** and **SMOKING** are allowed inside the inflatable at any time.

I understand that **NO** kind of **SPRAY STRING** is to be used near the inflatable because it can severely damage the vinyl.

Unless the inflatable is specifically designed to be a water ride, the inflatable SHOULD NOT GET WET.

I will not allow riders to do **FLIPS, CLIMB OR HANG ON THE NETTING** or **ROOF AREAS, or ROUGHHOUSE** in the inflatable. I will remove riders who do not follow directions to ensure the safety of all riders and to maintain the integrity of the equipment.

I will not allow riders to sit or play on the safety step of a bouncer or combo. I will not allow more than one rider at any time at the top of a slide.

I understand that riders should be sorted by size to prevent injuries. Only children of approximately the same size should be in the inflatable at any time. Max Occupants: Bounce/Combo Inflatables - Medium Ride 13'x13' (6), and Large Ride 15'x 15' (8). Slides (3) max at any time – one sliding down, 1 waiting at the top of the slide platform and one climbing the slide. For dual slides a total of four with 1 additional climbing the second slide. Never allow participants to gather at any point on the unit.

I agree not to exceed the recommended number of riders or weight limit. Weight capacity per rider should not exceed 200 pounds.

Safety and evacuation procedures in case of unit deflation have been reviewed with me. If the unit is a bounce house – it should be equipped with a Velcro escape hatch at top of the unit.

Inclement weather procedures have been reviewed with me. A plan is in place to notify the lessee three times of possible inclement weather. 1.) Prior to delivery notification 2.) Procedures reviewed with lessee upon delivery 3.) Phone call placed to lessee should inclement weather become a threat.

I am aware of how the weather can affect the inflatable and I have reviewed the procedures and understand what to do in the event of bad weather (rain or wind). Do not operate if wind exceeds 15+ mph. If strong winds occur, immediately remove riders from the unit. Then deflate the unit, unplug the blower(s) and extension cords and place the two under a shelter. If rain begins, remove riders, then unplug blower(s) and extension cords and place the two under a shelter. When rain stops, inflate unit and allow it to completely dry (including all seams) before allowing the riders to reenter the unit.

Individuals with pre-existing health conditions, such as individuals with head, neck, back or other muscular-skeletal injuries or disabilities, pregnant women, individuals with pre-existing injuries, individuals with heart problems/conditions, small infants, and others who may be susceptible to injury from falls, bumps or bouncing are not permitted in the unit(s) at any time. Individuals that are intoxicated or under the influence of alcohol or drugs should never be permitted on the ride at any time.

I understand that riders must slide in a sitting position, feet first. Jumping and flipping from the top of the slide is **NOT PERMITTED** and can cause injuries.

Each blower requires a constant source of 110v 20amp of power.
